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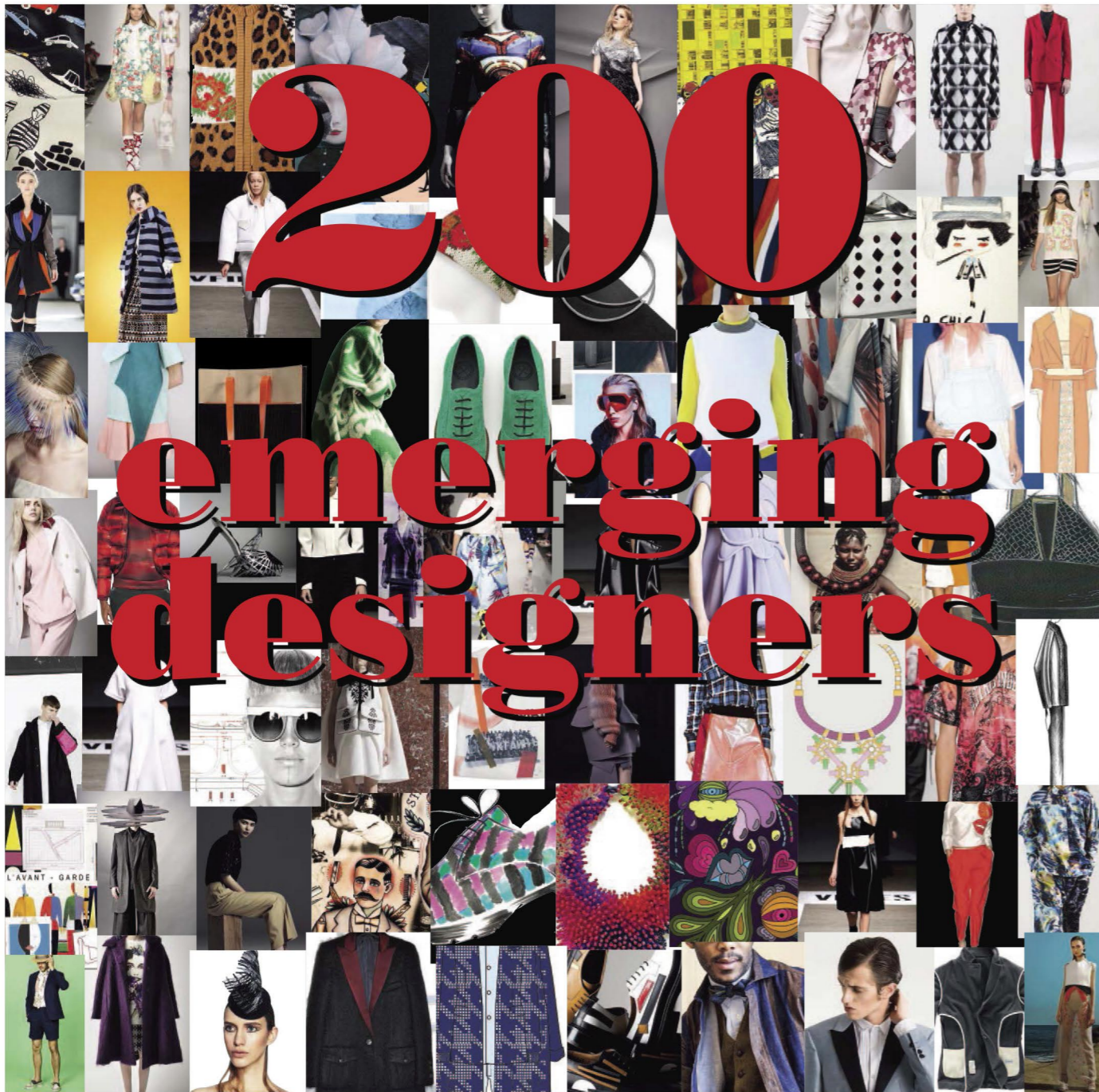

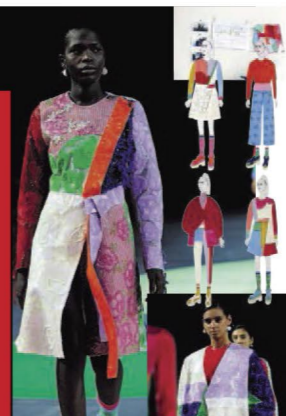

The Royal Academy was founded in 1663 by David Teniers the Younger, a painter to the Archduke Leopold and Don Juan of Austria. Designers who graduated here in the early 1980s include Ann Demeulemeester, Dirk Bikkembergs, Walter Van Beirendonck, Dries Van Noten and Martin Margiela. By that time media had started to take an interest in fashion designers from Antwerp.
