

Groundbreaking Ceremony of Raffles American School marks the beginning of a new era of world-class Education in Malaysia

Kuala Lumpur, January 8, 2013 – Malaysia’s first state-of-the-art Raffles American School (RAS) becomes a reality at the RAS Groundbreaking Ceremony held today in EduCity, Nusajaya. The 45-acre permanent campus is designed by the New York Architectural firm of SOM (Skidmore, Owings & Merrill LLP) and its first phase comprising a world-class educational infrastructure to support Kindergarten through Grade 12, including full boarding capacity is expected to be completed by the 2014-2015 school year.

From its current student count of 15 at its temporary campus in the Anjung Neighborhood Centre in Nusajaya, Iskandar; RAS will be well equipped and positioned to accommodate more than 500 students for grades 1 through 12 upon completion of its first phase in 2014.

More than 60% of RAS’ current student strength is from neighboring Singapore, owing to its proximity and of course, the innovative course structure and environment at RAS.

“What we envisioned with EduCity 5 years ago, is today a reality. The only multi-varsity campus in the region, EduCity is a melting pot with global citizens, diverse cultures, intelligent networks and new-age learning. With RAS, we are not only contributing to the national agenda of providing quality education of international standards, but are also helping Malaysia to emerge as a preferred destination for world-class primary, secondary and higher education in the region,” added President / CEO of IIB, Datuk Syed Mohamed Syed Ibrahim.

“What draws the attention to RAS is its uniquely designed curriculum to include rigorous and rich academic as well as co-curricular programs. The aspirations of RAS in Malaysia will be to help young people reach their potential by imbedding real-life, 21st century learning into each class day. By embedding learning outcomes such as communication skills, organizational and research skills, and problem solving/thinking skills into our curriculum at every level, students are poised for success in their next school or life opportunity,” concluded the Founding Superintendent of RAS, Dr. Rob Mockrish.

More About Raffles American School:

The Master Plan for Raffles American School (RAS) outlines the vision for a contemporary Pre-Kindergarten-through-12th Grade academy that will be unlike any that has preceded it in the region. Set amongst the lush rolling hills of Iskandar, Malaysia, the school is envisioned as a holistic learning environment where educational facilities and athletic and performing arts space will comprise an open network that is seamlessly interwoven into the beautiful outdoor landscape.

RAS offers an American pre-K-12 curriculum program, with Advanced Placement (AP) Offerings in the high school, which will provide a viable schooling alternative to the local and expatriate communities in the region. The curriculum at RAS is jointly developed by International Schools Services, New Jersey, USA (ISS), an established global company that has advanced the quality of international education for children across the world with its curriculum development, school management, supply sourcing and recruitment. RAS prepares students for admission to top US and Western Universities and is accredited by the Western Association of Schools and Colleges, USA (WASC).

The RAS campus will boast a 300,000 square feet of built-up space complete with sports, recreational and boarding facilities to cater for a capacity of 2,000 students. RAS will have a series of educational amenities, enhancing its students' experience. An indoor athletic complex will include a single and a double gymnasium, gymnastics and wrestling halls, several free activity rooms, and a training-and-weights room. A fully equipped performing arts center will house two venues for student productions: a state-of-the-art black box theater and an 800 seat traditional performing arts theater complete with back-of-house and fly-space facilities. At the northern head of the school, a dramatically terraced library and media center will contain a digital media lab, a stacks area, as well as a variety of "reading room" spaces that will offer students inspiring atmospheres in which to study, research and collaborate. At the southern end of the library, a 30-person planetarium will give teachers an immersive educational tool within which to expand on classroom lessons. A series of outdoor courtyards, designed to accommodate fruit and vegetable cultivation, together with a 160 sqm greenhouse, will allow food studies to take a more robust position in a student's curriculum.

The academic village and student housing will be flanked to the east and west by a collection of outdoor athletic spaces. These will include two swimming pools (an Olympic-sized 50-meter, and a smaller 25-meter), three tennis courts, a basketball court, a free-play area, a baseball field, a soccer field, and a 400-meter track containing spaces for the full spectrum of track-and-field events.
